



POP Fund thematic priorities

Projects can focus on one priority or align with multiple priorities, as long as the project constitutes a coherent entity with clearly defined goals and outcomes.

1 Improved living conditions of refugees residing outside of the main metropolises and in the rural areas, including support for voluntary relocation of refugees from metropolises, where the cost of living is high, to smaller towns, with lower cost of living.

2 Support for voluntary relocation of refugees from the mass accommodation centers.

Detailed info:

- The support package should include one or several components, such as improved accommodation, access to the labor market, education and other social services, support in local integration, etc.
- The support package should include refugees and host communities members facing similar challenges (number of host community beneficiaries up to $\frac{1}{3}$ or $\frac{1}{2}$ of all beneficiaries, depending on the project size).

3 Support to refugees facing barriers in accessing the labour market, including refugee women with children until the age of 7.

4 Support to older (retired) refugees, and/or persons with disability.

5 Support to inclusion and continuation of education of refugee children in the Polish schools.

6 Support for refugees from other groups at risk of social exclusion, including ethnic minorities and sexual minorities.

Detailed info:

- The support package should include refugees and host communities members facing similar challenges (number of host community beneficiaries up to $\frac{1}{3}$ or $\frac{1}{2}$ of all beneficiaries, depending on the project size).
